

### **CUSTOMS TERMS**

TSA & HOMELAND SECURITY: all agencies that due to regulations of the TSA (HOME LAND SECURITY) who coordinate the fight against terrorism, it is essential that all boxes or packages to be reviewed at the time they arrive the offices and customer information to ensure that these do not contain any hazardous or explosive material.

It is possible that some agencies will be visited by undercover TSA agents confirming that at this point the load is checked upon receipt. Also will be useful to ensure that content is described by the customers is real.

### **COLOMBIA**

#### **WE CANNOT TRANSPORT**

- Contents not declared on the customs form.
- Military toys.
- Military clothes or copies.
- Explosives or flammables.
- Pollutants.
- Jewelry or gems.
- Cash or Stock Certificates
- Spray or Aerosols.
- Glass objects. (In case of transportation it would be the client's responsibility).
- Commercial amounts (More than 6 units)
- Contents which price is more than \$2,000.00 USD or its equivalence in International currency.

### **ECUADOR**

1- You cannot send more than one (1) box with the same sender and the beneficiary. From the date 4-27-2007 packs more than 4kg or 8lbs, content or shipments over \$ 30 USD are subject to taxes at destination.

2- The customs of this country require a real NAME\_ADDRESS an ID from who receives the package, any package of 4 Lbs. Will be subject to pay taxes on arrival if customs officials consider (1-24-2008). It is mandatory to supply the ID and its legitimate, those who receive the shipment in ECUADOR, those who does not provide or supply the wrong number, will cause retention of shipment by the customs and indefinite delay of the delivery thereof.

We inform to all our users that ships to Ecuador that from the date 2 - 8-2008 all shipments in general must carry a bill of the content or the declaration of content, this statement will be provided by your agency.
